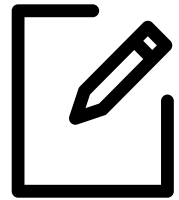

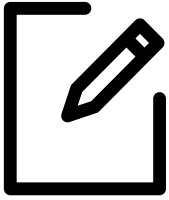

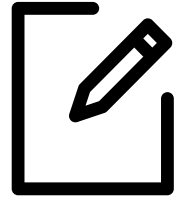

Tenses Quiz Answers



- 1 The future tense is used to express an action that will occur in the future.

- 2 The past simple tense is used to express completed actions or situations which happened in the past.

- 3 The present perfect tense is used to refer to activities or events which started in the past and continue up until now.

- 4 To form a question in the past continuous tense, you need to add "was/were" before the subject and then form the sentence as normal.

- 5 The past perfect tense is used to speak about actions or events which are still happening at a specific time in the past.

- 6 The present continuous tense is used for actions that are taking place currently, either at this moment or over a period of time which includes now.

- 7 In the future perfect simple tense, you use "will have + verb (past participle)".

- 8 For the past perfect simple tense, you use "had + verb (past participle)".
